## MINOR AMENDMENT REVIEW

### KENOGAMI FOREST 2011-2021 FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Ontario **Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF)**, **Ne-Daa-Kii-Me-Naan Inc.** and the **GERALDTON AREA NATURAL RESOURCES COMMITTEE** the Kenogami Forest's **Local Citizens' Committee (LCC)** invite you to review the MNRF-accepted minor amendment to the 2011-2021 Forest Management Plan (FMP) for the **KENOGAMI** Forest and to provide comments.

This amendment provides for a salvage harvest and subsequent regeneration of the NIP-013 fire that occurred north of the town of Geraldton adjacent to the Greenstone Airport in the spring of 2016.

Comments and/or concerns with respect to this minor amendment must be received within the 15-day review period and no later than **July 31, 2019** by Charlotte Bourdignon R.P.F.,

Management Forester of the Geraldton MNRF Office within Nipigon District. Further public consultation may be required if significant changes are required as a result of comments, otherwise, following the 15-day review period, the minor amendment will be approved. After approval the amendment will remain on the Ontario government website for the duration of the FMP.

During the 15-day review period, there is an opportunity to make a written request to seek resolution of issues with the MNRF District Manager or the Regional Director using a process described in the *Forest Management Planning Manual (2017) (Part C, Section 7.1.5)*.

The Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry is collecting your personal information and comments under the authority of the *Crown Forest Sustainability Act*. Any personal information you provide (address, name, telephone, etc.) will be protected in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*; however, your comments will become part of the public consultation process and may be shared with the general public.
