Notice of Public Information Session

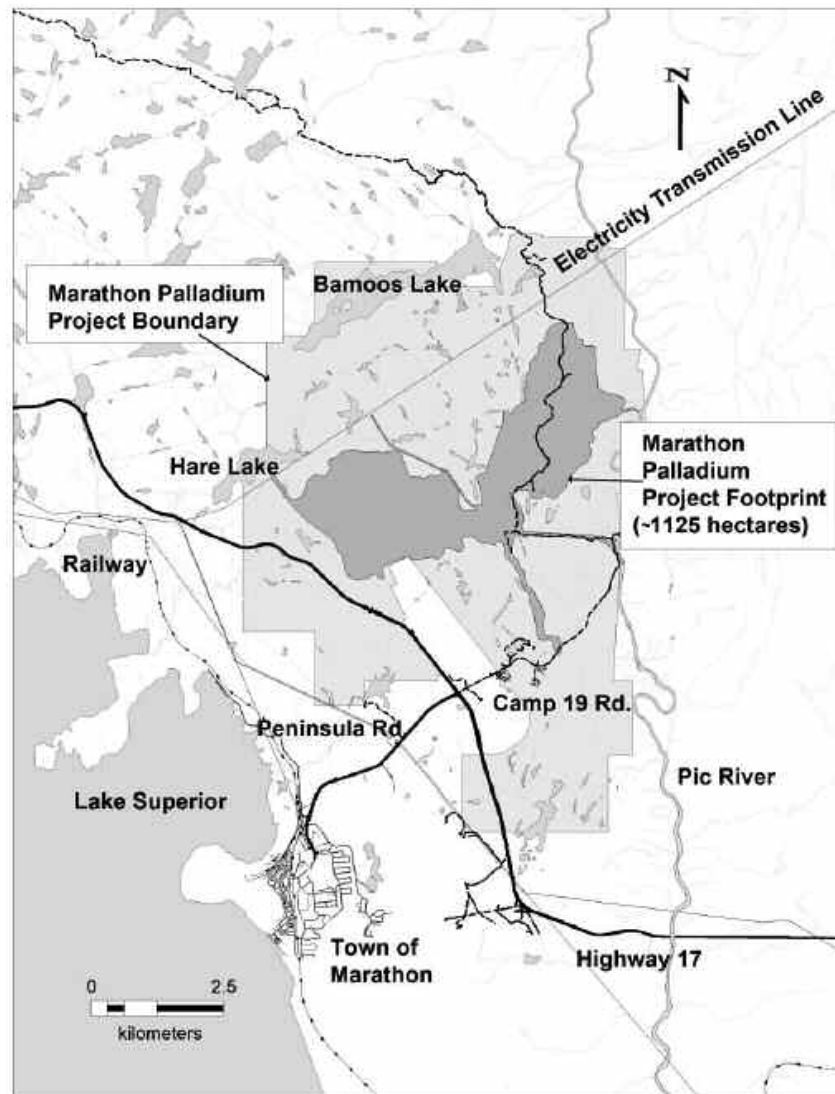
Generation PGM Inc. (GenPGM) invites you to a public information session regarding the Marathon Palladium Project (the Project). Weather-permitting, the event will be held outdoors. Social distancing will be respected, and Public Health Ontario Orders will be implemented that may limit the number of participants at the events. Everyone is asked to wear a mask if indoors.

GenPGM proposes to construct, operate and decommission an open pit palladium and copper mine and milling operation approximately 10 km north of the Town of Marathon.

The Project has a mine life of 13 years and includes a 25,200 tonne per day process plant. The Project also includes:

- site mix emulsion plant with explosives storage,
- rock piles with aggregate processing plant,
- process solids management facility with water management system,
- new transmission line and
- new access road that connects to the Camp 19 road.

The Project is currently subject to a joint federal-provincial environmental assessment process and updates are available at <https://iaac-aeic.gc.ca/050/evaluations/proj/54755?culture=en-CA>.

Pending the outcome of the environmental assessment and receipt of regulatory approvals, clearing would start in second half of 2022 followed by an estimated 2 year construction phase prior to commissioning and commencing commercial production.

Comments and personal information regarding this proposed project are being collected to assist government agencies in making decisions related to the environmental assessment and approvals process for this Project. Comments not constituting personal information as defined by the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, will be shared with government agencies and others as the government agencies consider appropriate, and may be included in documentation available for public review. Personal information will remain confidential unless prior consent to disclose is obtained, however this information may be used by government agencies to seek public input on other projects.
