- In collaboration with Greenstone Gold Mines' management, develop and execute the implementation of agreements between GGM and applicable Indigenous communities, including aspects such as employment and business opportunities, training and implementation committees.
- Foster and maintain strong relationships with our Indigenous partners
- Provide a local presence and facilitate coordination within the communities as required to attain their successful participating in the Project benefits in a manner consistent with the agreements.
- Engage community leadership and representatives, solicit on-going input and feedback, and collaborate on human resources, training, business, and other matters consistent with the agreements.
- Establish, implement and oversee GGM's Grievance Mechanism and consultation records, and other indigenous plan and commitments, and ensure GGM is in compliance with all requirements
- Lead the collaborative design and active participation in the Long Temp Relationship Agreement Implementation Committee.
